

#### **GET TO KNOW YOUR APPLIANCE**



#### How to get the best results from your dishwasher

- Check that your dishware is dishwasher safe
- Keep the spray arm clear of obstructions
- Load items so water from the spray arm can reach them
- Use correct detergent quantity
- Use liquid rinse aid
- · Clean the filter
- Run regular deep clean cycles
- Descale to remove mineral buildup
- Register your product to get streamlined service support.

#### LOAD DISHWARE

#### Tips for energy efficiency



- · Load the dishwasher to capacity.
- Remove large food scraps, but do not pre-rinse dishes as this uses more water and energy.
- Select the most appropriate program for each load. See 'Select a suitable cycle' for recommendations.





#### Load items effectively

Space items evenly in the drawer, with cups and containers facing down, so water from the spray arm can reach them and drain away.



#### Check for obstructions

Check there are no items that will prevent the spray arm from rotating.



#### Load cutlery correctly

Load sharp knives with handles up. Mix spoons, knives and forks in each section to prevent nesting.

#### **USE RINSE AID**



Rinse aid improves dry performance and prevents tarnishing on metal and streaks on glass and dishware. Fill the rinse aid dispenser before adding detergent.



**1.** Turn the plug anticlockwise and remove.



**2.** Pour rinse aid into the opening. If spilled, wipe immediately.



**3.** Refit the plug, turning clockwise until secure with the hand grip in a vertical position.

#### LOAD DETERGENT



#### We recommend:

 Premium powdered detergents and tablets to effectively clean dishes, utensils and filters in your dishwasher.



#### We do not recommend:

- Non-premium powdered detergents and tablets, as these can result in faster grease buildup and reduced wash performance.
- Detergent sheets, as these produce excessive foam.
- Handwashing dish detergents and laundry or other detergents.



#### If using powdered detergent

Press the latch to open the dispenser.

Add the recommended quantity of detergent, and close the dispenser. See Care and Maintenance guide for details.



#### If using tablets

Place a tablet directly into the cutlery basket, tablet tray, or the tub.

Ensure tablet is not touching cutlery, dishes, or drawer base.

#### **SELECT A SUITABLE CYCLE**



Each cycle is designed for a specific purpose and has different time, energy and water requirements. Choose a cycle that balances load type and efficiency to get the best results.

WASH PROGRAMS	
<b>ECO DEFAULT</b> For normally soiled dishes for optimum water and energy use. Typical items: plates, bowls, cutlery from regular meals	©
RINSE  Prevents odours and soils from drying on dishes.  Typical items: any items waiting for a full wash	© <b>-•</b> \$
HEAVY DRY+, QUICK, SANITISE  Designed for heavily soiled pots, pans and dishes.  Typical items: pots, pans, casserole dishes with baked-on food	©
MEDIUM DRY+, QUICK, SANITISE  For dishes that are quite heavily soiled or to remove food that has been left overnight.  Typical items: plates with dried food, serving dishes	©
LIGHT DRY+ For very lightly soiled dishes with easy-to-remove soils. No drying. Typical items: plates, bowls, cups, plastic items and glassware with minimal residue	©
60MIN DRY+ For dishes that are quite heavily soiled or food that has been left to dry overnight. No drying. Typical items: plates with dried food, serving dishes	© ————————————————————————————————————
GLASSWARE DRY+ For lightly soiled and heat sensitive crockery and glassware such as wine glasses. Typical items: fine china, glassware, heat-sensitive crockery	©

#### **SELECT A SUITABLE MODIFIER**

WASH MODIFIERS		
DRY+ DRY+ increases the final rinse temperature and the length of the drying phase.		
QUICK		
QUICK uses additional water and energy for a faster wash time.		
SANITIZE		
<b>SANITISE</b> increases rinse temperature to 70°C. This meets the sanitisation conditions required by Section 6, NSF 184.		
A successful cycle will end as normal. If the sanitise cycle is interrupted, an alert will sound and the sanitize indicator will flash. Press <b>START</b> It wice to clear alert. Repeat the cycle.

#### **SET A CYCLE**



#### Setting a wash program

1. Press WASH PROGRAM SELECTOR >> to scroll and select a wash program.


Press **START** ►II then close the drawer.



#### Setting a wash modifier


Press **MODIFIER SELECTOR** ★ to select a wash modifier.

Press **START** I to start the wash, then close the drawer.



#### Pausing a wash

Press START > II to pause the wash. Wait for three short and one long tone before opening the drawer.



#### Resuming a wash

Pres **START** ▶**II** to resume the wash, then close the drawer.



#### Cancelling a wash

Press and hold **On/Off** ① to cancel. The drawer will turn off when water has drained.

#### SET UP WI-FI AND REMOTE MODE

Connect your appliance to your home Wi-Fi to get software updates, receive wash notifications, customise settings and control your wash cycles remotely.

#### **Getting started**

- Ensure your home v network is turned on and there is no wash cycle in progress.
- You will be given step-by-step guidance on your mobile device.
- It may take up to 10 minutes to connect your appliance.





#### Connecting to Wi-Fi

1. Press and hold WASH
PROGRAM SELECTOR ≫ and
START ► II together for
four seconds.



2. Press and hold START ▶II to connect to the Wi-Fi network. When the Wi-Fi icon ♠ flashes, follow the prompts within the app to complete set-up.



**3.** Press and hold **On/Off ①** to save and leave the menu after Wi-Fi is connected.



#### Turning remote mode ON


Open the drawer. Press and hold WASH PROGRAM SELECTOR >> until a tone sounds and the Wi-Fi icon ?= flashes. Close the drawer within seven seconds.

#### **ADJUST THE SETTINGS**

Go to the app to adjust and customise your settings or follow the steps below to adjust settings directly on your dishwasher. Each setting is displayed using a different combination of indicator lights. Adjust a setting by matching the indicator combinations as shown in 'Settings'.


Before adjusting settings, clear active wash cycles and make sure the controls aren't in sleep mode:

- If an indicator is flashing Press and hold START ▶II to cancel an active wash cycle.
- If all indicators are off Press the WASH PROGRAM SELECTOR » or close and open the drawer to wake up the controls.




#### Access settings


1. Press and hold WASH
PROGRAM SELECTOR ≫ and
START ► II to access settings.



2. Press WASH PROGRAM
SELECTOR ≫ to scroll through
the available options.



**3.** Press **START** ► II to change the setting within an option.



#### **SETTINGS**



#### Wi-Fi (recommended)

Sanitize, Quiet, Dry+: ON. Wi-Fi: ON/OFF to set.

Connect your dishdrawer to your home network to operate it via the app and to receive updates.



#### Auto power-on

Dry+: ON.

Auto: ON/OFF to set.

Your DishDrawer™ Dishwasher is set to automatically power on for 30 seconds after a drawer is opened. This can be turned off.



#### Tones

Quiet, Dry+: ON. Auto: ON/OFF to set.

Adjust tone settings. When set to **OFF**, all tones will be silenced except fault alerts.



#### Rinse aid

Sanitize: ON.

Wash programs: 0-5 to set level.

Control the amount of rinse aid dispensed from 0—5 units. Units correspond to wash program indicator lights. Defaults to 3.



#### Water softener (some models)

Quiet: ON.

Wash programs: 0-5 to set level.

Set water hardness from 0–5. Setting corresponds to wash program indicator lights.

#### **SETTINGS**



#### Auto lock

Sanitize, Dry+: ON. Heavy: ON/OFF to set.

Automatically lock the drawer after 30 seconds to prevent opening during a wash cycle.



#### Default (some models)

Sanitize: ON.


Auto: ON/OFF to set.

Automatically default to **ECO** when in standby mode. This can be turned off.



#### **Setting DELAY START**

Press and hold START ▶II. When pressed, each tone indicates +1 hour (12 max). Press On/Off ⊕ to cancel. DELAYED START INDICATOR ⊖ and DRAWER INDICATOR ⊟ will flash when the timer begins.



#### Locking the controls

Lock indicator: ON.

Press and hold WASH CYCLE
SELECTOR >> and WASH
MODIFIER SELECTOR \*\* together
for two seconds. The lock \*\*
will illuminate



#### Unlocking the controls

Lock indicator: OFF.

Press and hold WASH CYCLE
SELECTOR ≫ and WASH
MODIFIER SELECTOR ★ together
until you hear a tone, and the
lock icon ⊕ dims.

#### MAINTAIN WASH PERFORMANCE

Make these steps a regular part of your cleaning routine to get the best results from your appliance.

#### Keep the spray arm clear

Check that nothing is obstructing the spray arm. Regularly remove and clean it with hot water and a cloth to unblock the spray holes.

#### Use correct detergent quantity

You may need to adjust detergent quantity based on local water hardness. Scan the QR code below for recommended detergent quantities.

#### Use rinse aid

Rinse aid prevents water beading on dishes, glasses and cutlery, so dishes dry faster and do not develop white spots.

#### Clean the filter

A blocked filter reduces the water pressure required to clean dishes. Remove and clean the filter regularly in hot, soapy water to remove food and grease buildup.

#### Run regular deep clean cycles

Run a cycle every few months to remove grease and buildup and more often if you use Eco detergents or low-temperature cycles. Use a premium dishwashing cleaner, follow label instructions, and run the **HEAVY** or **HEAVY SANITIZE** cycle.

#### Descale to remove mineral buildup

Fill the detergent dispenser and secondary compartment with citric acid crystals or descaler. Run the dishwasher on the **HEAVY** cycle followed by a wash program with detergent immediately after.
