Choosing the right cycle for your laundry is the best way to ensure optimal results. We've included some helpful tips for how to select the right cycle and get the most from your appliance.

Your appliance uses a fibre-led system and precision sensing to remove the guesswork and ensure effortless care for every corner of your wardrobe.

Each fibre has unique care requirements when it comes to washing, drying and other laundry treatments. By tailoring the cycles to suit each load, you can preserve the quality and extend the lifespan of your items.

Specialised care cycles

Your appliance has a range of specialised cycles tailored for specific fibre types, that can be further refined to suit your laundry needs. Start by selecting your fibre type, then select an item type based on durability or specific items such as sheets or towels, and your required treatment. You can also adjust additional settings such as soil level, colour and dryness.

Removing the guesswork

Your appliance will adjust the cycle to give the best performance for your items. To ensure optimal results, the available cycle options may vary depending on the fibre type you select.

Cycle settings like temperature and spin speed no longer need to be set manually. These settings will all adjust automatically based on your selections.



Item care labels

For best results, check the care labels on each of your items to understand what fibre or fibres they are made of and how they should be cared for.

- Items may be made up of multiple fibres, some more delicate than others.
- We recommend setting your cycle to suit the most delicate fibre present in any item or in a load.
- For everyday laundry with a mixture of fibres and for cotton-polyester blends, we recommend using the Mixed fibre option.



Sorting & loading

To ensure more specialised care, we recommend sorting your laundry into loads with similar fibres, durability, items and colours.

- Separate delicate items from more heavy duty and durable items.
- Check pockets, secure fasteners and untangle items before loading.
- Take care not to overload the appliance and allow enough room for airflow or for items to move freely.
- Some cycles may have specific recommendations for maximum load size or number of items.
